NOTICE FOR PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX FOR BUFFALO GROVE PARK DISTRICT

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Buffalo Grove Park District for 2007 will be held on December 27, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. at 530 Bernard Drive, Buffalo Grove, Illinois.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2006 were \$5,389,489.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$6,537,912. This represents a 21.31% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2006 were \$1,515,417.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2007 are \$1,452,000. This represents a 4.18 % decrease over the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2006 were \$6,904,906.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$7,989,912. This represents a 15.71% increase over the previous year.
