Dear Parents and Campers,

Welcome to the Buffalo Grove Park District's Adventure 1-2 Summer Camp at Tripp School, 850 Highland Grove Drive, Buffalo Grove! My name is Katie Michaels, and I will be the camp supervisor this summer. I just finished my junior year at Illinois State University and am super excited to start student teaching next fall at Prospect High School. This will be my fifth year working for the park district, and I am so thrilled to start another fun and action-packed summer!

Camp starts at 9 a.m. Your child can be dropped off in front of Tripp School with his or her counselor. Please do not drop off your camper earlier than 8:55 a.m. The counselors and I will be inside getting ready for the day until then. Camp ends at 3 p.m. We will meet back in the front of the school in order for you to pick up your child. If you plan on carpooling or having another relative pick up your child, please send a note explaining who they will be leaving with at the end of the day.

A good portion of our time at Adventure camp will be spent outside playing fun games! Because of this, we suggest that you send your child with a water bottle as well as apply sunscreen before camp. Because of safety reasons, counselors and I will not be able to apply sunscreen on your child. Please also make sure that your child wears socks and gym shoes to camp everyday. Campers will need a lunch, drink, and snack daily.

We will be swimming four days a week at camp. Tuesdays and Thursdays the campers will be going to the Aquadome Pool at Buffalo Grove High School for swim lessons. Lessons will be from 10:30-11:35. On Wednesdays and Fridays, we will be going to Willow Stream pool for free swim from 9:10-11:00. On Wednesdays and Fridays, please send your child already wearing his or her swim suit so we are able to leave on time. Please make sure that your camper has appropriate clothes to change into after free swim.

On the first day of camp, you will receive a camp calendar that will help you keep track of all the fun field trips and other events that we will be enjoying together. The calendar will also include important dates such as the camp cookout and camp pictures. I will also be sending home a weekly letter which will include reminders about upcoming events.

The first day of camp is June 16th. The counselors and I are so excited for camp to start. I look forward to meeting you all and having a fantastic summer!
